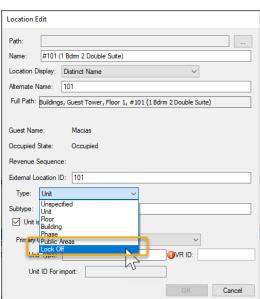
New Location Type: Lock-Off

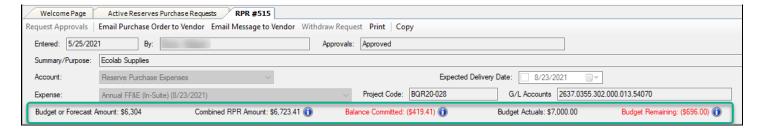
Expense/Expense Series, Limit Associated Asset Types List by Account

We have rearranged and added additional pieces of information to the RPR detail screen for a more informed request workflow.



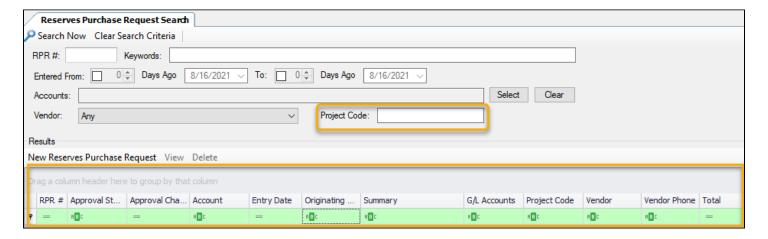
You will now find the following changes:
